TREE HOUSES, STEIRERECK AM POGUSCH

You only see them when you are almost in front of them. The tree houses on the Pogusch are hidden in the light spruce forest. The Pogusch, a pass between Kapfenberg and Turnau in the Styrian Mürz Valley, attracts guests in both summer and winter. Since this year, guests have been able to spend the night in high quality in the wooden houses. The four tree houses called Bert can be assembled to any shape and size using room elements and modules and have high ecological standards as well as minimal soil sealing as their goal. Only 2 m² per building are sealed on the surface.

Sustainability has found its way out of the niche into the masses. The issues of ecological footprint and surface sealing meanwhile affect everyone. Demand is no longer just about size, but also about healthy living.

The PICHLER comfort ventilation, which is pre-cooled or pre-heated by the ground, ensures a healthy indoor climate in the tree houses in a sustainable and super-efficient manner - and helps to stop global climate change.
